- Asian-Canadians living in Nova Scotia may also be listed within the ‘regions of Asia’:
  - **South Asia:** The region consists of Afghanistan, Pakistan, India, Nepal, Bhutan, Bangladesh, the Maldives and Sri Lanka.
  - **Southeast Asia** consists of Laos, Vietnam, West Malaysia, Thailand, Myanmar, and Cambodia. Indonesia, East Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Brunei, East Timor and sometime Taiwan.
  - **West Asia** consists of Armenia, Azerbaijan, Bahrain, Cyprus, Georgia, Iran, Iraq, Israel, Jordan, Kuwait, Lebanon, Oman, Palestine, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Syria, Turkey, United Arab Emirates & Yemen.
  - **East Asia** consists of China, Mongolia, North Korea, South Korea, Japan, Hong Kong, Taiwan and Macau.
